*I asked [ REDACTED ] if her and her friend any conversation with the bartender or anyone else in the bar and she told me that they did not [ REDACTED ] did mention that the bartender asked the girls if they were by themselves or with dates.*

*The girls told the bartender that it was just the two of them out tonight.*

**LATER PARAGRAPH IN THE SAME NARRATIVE:**

*The next thing [ REDACTED ] remembers is waking up in bed the next day next to [ REDACTED ] at [ REDACTED ] apartment at approximately 1000 hours.*

*Neither girl could remember how they got home or any of the events that occurred after they were inside [ a Hermosa Beach nightclub ]*

*[ REDACTED ] told me that they didn't drive home because [ REDACTED ] car wasn't in the driveway. [ REDACTED ] very faintly remembers being dropped off at her friend's apartment but she wasn't sure by whom.*

*[ REDACTED ] stated that both she and [ REDACTED ] felt horrible when they woke up. Both girls felt sick and were vomiting and had horrible headaches. [ REDACTED ] told me that she had been hung-over from alcohol before in the past but this was a different feeling than a normal hangover.*

*[ REDACTED ] identified the voice as male and said she kept silent because she was afraid she would be harmed if she did not obey.*

*After being dragged a short distance she was laid on her back on concrete and heard one of the suspects state, "Hold her down," at which time her arms were held down at her sides.*

*[ REDACTED ] said that a second suspect then removed her shoes and pulled on the fly area of her jeans so aggressively that they (the jeans) tore.*

*Once the fly of her jeans had been torn open the suspect removed them (the jeans).*

*[ REDACTED ] stated she was not wearing panties at the time of the assault.*

*Once the suspect removed her jeans, he laid on top of her and penetrated her . . .*

After they all ate, the four of them and two other male friends of (NFI on two the male friends) walked W/B across Hermosa Av (1100 block Hermosa Av), where they got into a green taxi van. stated they took a taxi to and apartment complex to freshen up and relax for a few minutes.

does not recall the exact route the taxi took, but she recalls that as she was getting off the taxi, it was facing E/B on a steep hill. She stated that the large apartment complex was to her right on the corner of an intersection in a residential area.

recalls the apartment complex as a large, white apartment complex with many plants and bushes to the right and to the left of the apartment's green metal entrance which faced E/B. recalls taking a small set of stairs down (W/B) towards the green metal entrance, where opened the gate. As entered, she noticed metal mail boxes to her right and to her left hanging from the walls also recalls a large mirror on the right wall and a second door that lead to the apartments. As they all went through the second door, she recalls making a left turn (Now facing S/B), off the curb, then making a right turn down a hill (W/B) where she noticed several cars parked. On 3-15-10 at 1145 hours, I was dispatched to LCM(Little Company of Mary Hospital) Emergency Room in Torrance regarding a possible rape that occurred in Hermosa Beach. Upon arrival I met victim [REDACTED] in ER Room 25. While [REDACTED] was being treated by hospital staff, I made a phone call to the Sexual Assault Response Team (SART). I spoke to a Forensic Nurse Examiner by the name of [REDACTED]. She advised me to take the patient to the Rape Crisis Center located at 514 Prospect Avenue in Redondo Beach.

On same date at about 1300 hours, I responded to the Rape Crisis Center with victim [REDACTED] and her two friends, [REDACTED] both listed on face page of this report as witnesses. Upon arrival to the location I met the Forensic Nurse Examiner, [REDACTED]. Both [REDACTED] and I sat down with [REDACTED] in a private room and started the interview with her.

[REDACTED] told me that she was staying at the Crown Plaza in Redondo Beach (300 N Harbor Drive) with her friends in room [REDACTED]. She said that they were getting ready to go out to the bars in Hermosa. While getting ready she told me that she consumed three shots of Vodka between the time of 2230 and 2300 on 3-14-10. [REDACTED] said that she and her friends took a cab from the Crown Plaza Hotel at about 2305 hours and arrived downtown Hermosa at about 2315 hours. She said that they went right to Sharkeez (52 Pier Plaza). Once inside she consumed two beers and one more shot. [REDACTED] told me that all she remembers was sitting at the bar, then getting up going to the restroom and then returning to the bar. [REDACTED] told me that she has no idea what time she left the bar and has no idea who she left the bar with. [REDACTED] told me that after returning from the restroom, she returned to the bar. The next memory she had, was when she woke up naked, next to a WMA, in a small apartment. She said she saw that her clothes were on the floor next to the bed and noticed that it was about 0830 am. She said the WMA about 20 to 25 years old was in his underwear lying next to her. As she was getting dressed she asked him what his name was and he said [REDACTED] (NFD, NFI). She then asked him if they had sex and he said, "No". [REDACTED] asked him what her friends said when they left together. He stated, "We never spoke to your friends, we just left". Source: On 12/10/10 at 1417 hours, Hermosa Police units were dispatched to [REDACTED] regarding an unknown female who had just ran up to the R/P stating she had been kidnapped and raped for the past two days. Paramedics were also dispatched. Upon my arrival, I met the victim (later identified as [REDACTED]) who was sitting down on a step in front of location. [REDACTED] was visibly upset and crying hysterically. I attempted to speak with [REDACTED] to find out the specifics on what had occurred, but I had difficulty understanding what [REDACTED] was saying due to her being so distraught. As I was speaking with [REDACTED] I recognized her as someone I had contacted months prior and I recalled she resided at an address somewhere near the [REDACTED]. At that time, paramedics began treating [REDACTED] for possible injuries while Officer McDermott and I began searching for [REDACTED] residence. Officer Droz contacted the R/P [REDACTED] at the same time and obtained her statement. See Officer Droz's supplemental report same DR # for complete statement.

During our search of the area, I recognized the location of my prior contact with [REDACTED] which was in front of [REDACTED]. I viewed the outside mailboxes and recognized the name on [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was known to me as a friend of [REDACTED] who had allowed [REDACTED] to stay at his residence. As I approached the front door, I noticed it was partially open. I knocked several times on the door before announcing my presence and calling his name, [REDACTED]. After receiving no answer, I believed [REDACTED] may be inside and I was unsure of his condition. Therefore, Sgt. Phillips, Officer's Droz, McDermott, and I entered the residence to conduct a protective sweep due to concerns for [REDACTED] well being. We did not find anybody inside however, we did observe in plain view, photos of [REDACTED] and her personal belongings throughout the residence. Officer Droz took photos of the residence and logged them into evidence.

[REDACTED] was transported by paramedics to Little Company of Mary Hospital for further evaluation. I drove to Little Company of Mary Hospital and re-contacted [REDACTED] at the hospital where she provided me with a limited statement. [REDACTED] was still very upset which made it difficult to understand what she was telling me. Her statements were incomplete and at times, just didn't make sense. From what I could understand and piece together, on 12/08/10 at an unknown time, the suspect [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED] residence with his sister [REDACTED]. Both removed [REDACTED] from her residence against her will and drove her to [REDACTED] residence. [REDACTED] took [REDACTED] and placed her inside his bedroom closet while he prepared the bed (unk what that meant). [REDACTED] then removed [REDACTED] clothes and placed her on his bed where he had sexual intercourse with [REDACTED] in different positions for several hours. [REDACTED] threatened to harm [REDACTED] friends so she feared trying to fight back or run away. While they were having sex, [REDACTED] stated to [REDACTED], "Don't look at me...I'm gonna' f [REDACTED] you from behind." [REDACTED] also recalled stating at some point during the sex, "If you're gonna' do anything, try to make it attractive." I asked [REDACTED] what she meant by that statement and she was unable to explain it. Several hours later, [REDACTED] put her clothes back on after [REDACTED] stated, "Get dressed we gotta go now, and shut up." After [REDACTED] got dressed [REDACTED] drove her back to [REDACTED] and set her free. [REDACTED] said this pattern of abuse was then repeated the following day. Per [REDACTED] [REDACTED] never kept her captive more than a few hours each day.

During my interview, Detective Bohacik arrived so I stepped out of the room to brief him on what [REDACTED] had told me so far. The social worker [REDACTED] also arrived and assisted with the interview. Detective Bohacik later transported [REDACTED] to San Pedro Rape Center for a forensic exam. See Detective Bohacik's investigation report for further.

[REDACTED] said she has known [REDACTED] for approximately four (4) years and met him through her friend [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] claims she did not consent to having sexual intercourse with [REDACTED] at anytime during this incident. She described [REDACTED] as a male white in his 30's. She believes he lives either in [REDACTED]. I contacted records and had them run a records check on the name/information [REDACTED] had provided. The records system returned with a match showing an address of [REDACTED]. The records system also showed prior arrests of [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] being an associated person of his. Further, the system showed [REDACTED] was listed as a suspect against [REDACTED].

## Narrative

On 01-03-11 at approximately 1830 hours, I responded to Anaheim Memorial Hospital (1111 W. La Palma Avenue, Anaheim 92801) regarding a possible rape report. Upon my arrival I contacted [REDACTED] who was waiting to be examined by a SART nurse.

[REDACTED] told me that she admitted herself into the emergency room a few hours prior to my arrival because she believes that she might have been drugged and raped on 01-02-11 by a bartender in Hermosa Beach. I asked [REDACTED] why she waited almost 24 hours before admitting herself to the hospital and filing a police report and she told me that she just developed a rash on her vagina and she was concerned that it might be a sexual transmitted disease (STD). [REDACTED] then continued to tell me how she thought she received the STD.

On 01-01-11 at approximately 2330 hours, [REDACTED] said she went to go visit her friend [REDACTED] who lives in Redondo Beach. [REDACTED] said that she and [REDACTED] planned on going out to the bars in Hermosa Beach for a few hours. Prior to them leaving [REDACTED]'s house, [REDACTED] said that they both had one regular size glass of wine. The friends then drove to Hermosa Beach in [REDACTED] car and went to the "Ocean Bar" at Union Cattle Company [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said that they arrived at the bar at approximately 0030 hours. Once inside the bar, [REDACTED] noticed that the bar was not very crowded. She said they walked up to the bar counter and they each ordered a martini. [REDACTED] said she watched the bartender mix the drinks and serve them. [REDACTED] said they got their drinks and sat down at a nearby table. [REDACTED] then said that the same bartender walked over and gave them a complimentary shot of "seagrams sweet tea". [REDACTED] and her friend thanked the bartender and drank the shot. [REDACTED] told me that the shot was very "partially", meaning that it had appeared to have particles of some unknown substance in the drink. I asked [REDACTED] if her and her friend had any conversation with the bartender or anyone else in the bar and she told me that they did not. [REDACTED] did mention that the bartender asked the girls if they were by themselves or with dates. The girls told the bartender that it was just the two of them out tonight.

After [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] finished there drink they decided to go to the "Underground Pub" (1334 Manhattan Avenue). I asked [REDACTED] how long they were at Ocean Bar for and she estimated about 30 minutes. Once they arrived at the Underground Pub, [REDACTED] said that they were not allowed inside the bar because it was just about to close for the night. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] then decided to go to "Café Boogaloo" (1238 Hermosa Avenue). I asked [REDACTED] if she felt intoxicated at this point and she said she could not remember how she felt. Once

they arrived at Café Boogaloo, ██████ said that the doorman at the club would not let them in because the bar was closing in a few minutes. ██████ then remembers an unknown male telling the doorman "let them in". ██████ told me that it might have been the bartender from Ocean Bar who said that but she is not positive. I asked ██████ if she noticed if anybody was following them as they were walking to each bar but she told me that she couldn't remember.

While inside Café Boogaloo, ██████ told me that she could only remember a few details. ██████ remembers being inside the bar and talking to the bartender from Ocean Bar and one of his friends but she can't remember what the conversation consisted of. While inside the bar she remembers having 2 drinks but she can't recall what kind of drinks they were. ██████ said she believes they were at the bar for approximately one hour, but her concept of time was probably impaired. The next image ██████ remembers is being inside a strange apartment talking to an unknown female about an unknown topic. ██████ had no idea how she arrived at this apartment or who she was with. She stated that she had no idea how long she was inside the apartment or if she was sexually assaulted. She also can't recall if her friend ██████ was inside the apartment with her.

The next thing ██████ remembers is waking up in bed the next day next to ██████ at ██████ apartment at approximately 1000 hours. Neither girl could remember how they got home or any of the events that occurred after they were inside Café Boogaloo. ██████ told me that they didn't drive home because ██████ car wasn't in the driveway. ██████ very faintly remembers being dropped off at her friend's apartment but she wasn't sure by whom. ██████ stated that both she and ██████ felt horrible when they woke up. Both girls felt sick and were vomiting and had horrible headaches. ██████ told me that she has been hung-over from alcohol in the past but this was a different feeling than a normal hangover. I asked ██████ if she had any pain or discomfort in her vagina when she woke up and she told me she did not. She also said that it felt like her vagina had not been penetrated. Both girls tried to piece together the events of the previous night but neither one could remember anything after they entered into Café Boogaloo. ██████ said later on that day she eventually ended driving back home to Santa Ana. At this point ██████ didn't believe that any sexual assault had taken place. ██████ said she still was confused why she blacked out because she usually is very responsible when drinking alcohol. In total, ██████ remembers having 5 drinks. She also stated that she had a large dinner a few hours prior to drinking so her reaction to the alcohol was not normal.

On the evening of 01-02-11, ██████ discovered a red rash on her vagina. She had no idea where the rash came from or how she might have received it. It was then that she formed the conclusion that she might have possibly been drugged and raped. She feared that the rash might possibly have been an STD. I asked her if she had any injuries on her body and she stated that there was light bruising on her upper thigh and some slight scratches that were not there prior to the night of 01-01-11. The following day (01-03-11) ██████ first went to the "Planned Parenthood" and then to the hospital to get evaluated. It was at this time that she decided to call the HBPD to file a report. At the time this report was taken, ██████ said she still felt sick and that she was still vomiting.

██████ told me that she is unsure if she was raped but she firmly believes that she was drugged by the bartender from Ocean Bar. She described the bartender as a male white adult in his mid to late 20's. He was approximately 5'11 and weighed between 160-180 pounds. He was wearing a v-neck white T-shirt and a pair of dark blue jeans and his hair was short and spiked. ██████ described his friend as a male Hispanic or Latin, approximately 5'8 and he was wearing a hooded sweatshirt. ██████ told me that if she saw a picture of the bartender that she would be able to positively identify him. ██████ said that she is desirous of prosecution.

I booked into evidence the sexual assault kit (tag # 6976) and the clothes ██████ was wearing the night of 01-01-11 (tag # 6975). It should be noted that ██████ clothes have not been washed since the incident occurred.

On Monday 01-31-11 at approximately 1212 hours, I [REDACTED] was dispatched to [REDACTED] (Gynecology Specialist) regarding a 261(a) PC rape report. Upon arrival I contacted the victim ([REDACTED]) who told me the following:

[REDACTED] said that on Sunday 01-30-11 at approximately 2100 hours, her and three female friends ([REDACTED] & [REDACTED] NFI) were walking along on Pier Plaza looking for a place to eat. [REDACTED] said that a male subject [REDACTED] who she described as white male with a shaved head, light pale skin, wearing a hooded sweatshirt approached them on the plaza because he had recognized one of her friend's [REDACTED]. BBQ / 20 Pier Ave). They stayed at Silvio's until approximately 0030 hours, then they moved to The Shore (1320 Hermosa Ave). While at The Shore, they briefly met with approximately eight of [REDACTED] college friends. After [REDACTED] friends left, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] took seats near a portion of the bar which was on the far east side of the building's interior. While at the bar, [REDACTED] was approached by an unidentified male subject (Involved Party #1). Involved Party #1 initiated conversation with her and bought her two "Gummy Bear" shots. He stayed with her for approximately 5 to 10 minutes and then left her seating area. In addition to these two shots, [REDACTED] also consumed approximately 6 ounces of beer. At approximately 0100 hours, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] left The Shore, and then waited in line to get into Chelsea Pub and Lounge (1332 Hermosa Ave). [REDACTED] did not recall how long she waited to get into Chelsea Pub and Lounge, she did not remember ever entering it, and she had no recollection of any events between then and when she first discovered she was inside of Suspect #1's residence. She also claimed that the above alcohol was the only alcohol which she had consumed that evening.

[REDACTED] next recollection was of lying down on her stomach in Suspect #1's bed. The lights were off and her body was covered by a blanket. While she was lying down, her head was facing to her left, and the suspect was positioned somehow behind her. He was penetrating her vagina (she believed with his penis). She was unable to verbally communicate with the suspect. She vomited and then went back to sleep. Her recollection of this incident was limited to approximately two seconds of awareness of her situation before falling back to sleep. She did not know what time this first sexual act occurred, she did not know how long he had been penetrating her vagina prior to her awareness of the act, she did not know if he continued penetrating her vagina after he went back to sleep, and she never gave permission to the suspect to penetrate her vagina in anyway.

[REDACTED] woke up again at approximately 0800 hours. Her body was in a similar position as it had been during the previous sexual act, and the suspect was again behind her penetrating her vagina (she believed with his penis). She exclaimed "Whoa!" and the suspect immediately stopped penetrating her vagina. From the time she first noticed intercourse occurring to the time it stopped was approximately one second. Again, she did not know how long he had been penetrating her vagina prior to her awareness of it. She noticed that she was wearing her bra and blouse/dress from the previous evening; however she was not wearing her panties or black elastic pants. [REDACTED] asked the suspect where she was. He told her she was at his residence. The suspect proceeded to tell her that he was friends with [REDACTED]. He had met her and [REDACTED] the previous evening, and the two females returned to his residence. [REDACTED] later left the location at an unspecified time. The suspect called [REDACTED] after she left and she told him she was at Pedones Pizza (1332 Hermosa Ave). Although [REDACTED] felt very confused, she did not recall feeling inebriated or sick. She remembered the suspect as being very friendly to her. The suspect recovered her underwear and pants from the floor for her. She redressed and left the suspect's residence within approximately five minutes of waking up. She then walked back to her car which was parked in the front parking lot of Mama D's. The suspect escorted her up to the area of Scotty's on The Strand (1100 The Strand); until she told him to stop escorting her. She walked the rest of the way to her car by herself. [REDACTED] then drove herself to her friend [REDACTED] residence ([REDACTED]). [REDACTED] then drove her to the HBPD to file this report.

[REDACTED] claimed that she never gave Suspect #1 permission to penetrate her body in any way, she did not approve of any sexual activity between him and her, she was not sure of the full extent of the sexual activity which occurred between her and the suspect (due to possibly having been drugged), and she is desirous of prosecution. Although she was certain that her vagina was penetrated on at least the above two occasions, she did not know if any other sexual activities occurred (such as oral copulation or anal penetration). She noticed discomfort in her vaginal region. She did not notice any discomfort in the area of her anus. She also claimed that she had started her period two days prior to this report, and that a tampon had been inside of her vagina prior to this incident. During our interview, she told me that she was unable to locate her tampon. She did not know if it had been removed, or if it had been pushed further inside of her.

I transported [REDACTED] Torrance, CA for a SART examination. She was introduced to Forensic [REDACTED] and a rape crises counselor from the YWCA who verbally identified herself as "[REDACTED]". I provided [REDACTED] with a Marsy's Card (victim bill of rights pamphlet) while in the presence of Forensic Nurse [REDACTED].

On Tuesday 7-12-11 at 1519 hours, I (Droz) responded to the LASD Century Regional Detention Facility (11703 Alameda Street, Lynwood, CA) regarding an inmate reporting a sexual assault which had occurred in Hermosa Beach.

I contacted the victim [REDACTED]. The interview occurred inside of a private visitation room which was located in the jail's inmate reception facility. [REDACTED] was in custody due to a felony warrant which had been issued for her arrest regarding theft related charges.

[REDACTED] told me that from 10-20-10 to 5-13-11, she resided at a residential drug and alcohol treatment program located in [REDACTED]. While residing there, she met a female friend named [REDACTED]. On 12-26-10, [REDACTED] met [REDACTED] father [REDACTED] when he was visiting his daughter. [REDACTED] would often converse with [REDACTED] when he would visit his daughter. On 4-24-11, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] (herein referred to as [REDACTED]) eventually exchanged telephone numbers.

On 4-26-11, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] met approximately two blocks away from Pacifica House. During this meeting, they consensually kissed each other for approximately 5 to 10 minutes.

On 4-28-11, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] met each other for approximately 2 ½ hours (2000 hours to 2330 hours). Their meeting started at Coffee Bean and Tea Leaf [REDACTED], and then progressed to [REDACTED] vehicle where they spent between a half hour to an hour together. While inside of [REDACTED] vehicle, the following consensual activities occurred: they kissed each other [REDACTED] manually stimulated the exterior of

Source: On 10-11-11 at 1433 hours, I was dispatched to Little Company of Mary Hospital regarding a female who believes she was sexually assaulted several nights ago after attending a local night club in our city; possibly Sangria's. Upon my arrival, I met the victim [REDACTED] who essentially stated the following:

Details: On 10-08-11 at approximately 2100 hours, she and her sister (IP-1 [REDACTED]) went to a friend's house (only known as [REDACTED]) to have some drinks. The victim could not recall the address but knew that it was somewhere located in the city of Manhattan Beach. The victim had one beer while at [REDACTED] house before they all went to Shellback's night club in Manhattan Beach and continued drinking. The same day at approximately midnight, the victim recalls hearing [REDACTED] suggest to her that they go to downtown Hermosa Beach to meet [REDACTED] boyfriend. The victim doesn't remember anything after this point and describes her mental state as "fuzzy". When asked, the victim was unable to recall how much alcohol she had consumed while at Shellback's but doesn't think it was much based on her discovering a Shellback's receipt in her purse after waking up the next day. The receipt was for a purchase of \$16.00 but was not available to take possession of for evidence. The victim mentioned that she briefly recalls her standing in front of her residence sometime during the late morning hours.

On 10-09-11 at around 1230 hours, the victim awoke in her pajamas and felt a "weird" feeling in her vaginal area as if she had sex or someone had inserted their fingers inside her vagina. The victim then searched for her tampon, which she had inserted since she was on her menstrual cycle, but could not locate it. The victim also discovered her cell phone missing, which she later reported lost/stolen to Verizon. A short time following, the victim received a phone call from her mother (IP-2 [REDACTED]) asking why she had arrived home so late at 0330 hours in the morning. Later that same day, the victim spoke with [REDACTED] and inquired about what had happened. Per the victim, [REDACTED] told her that they both went to a few bars in Hermosa Beach but ended up in Sangria's. The victim wanted to stay inside the club but [REDACTED] wanted to leave. [REDACTED] asked the victim to leave three (3) separate times but she refused. [REDACTED] then left without her.

On 10-10-11 after receiving her new cell phone from Verizon, she had received a text message from an unknown caller [REDACTED]. The message consisted of picture of a smiley face. The victim, not recognizing the number listed on her display, texted back twice, "who is this?" She never receive a response.

On 10-11-11 at around 1000 hours, the victim contacted her personal Physician ([REDACTED]) and

scheduled an appointed that day after explaining the situation. During the visit, [REDACTED] discovered the victim's tampon inserted deep inside her vagina. [REDACTED] extracted the tampon and secured it inside a paper bag. She then advised the victim to go to LCM Hospital and have the police contacted.

On 10-11-10 at 1541 hours after completing my interview, I contacted the Forensic Nurse [REDACTED] and explained what I had. [REDACTED], due to the circumstances of this particular case and the amount of time that had elapsed, a forensic exam is not needed.

I then re-contacted the victim and explained the situation. The victim told me that her main concern was protection of any STD's. The victim admits to being heavily intoxicated, which is what probably caused the memory loss. She strongly feels she had sexual intercourse with someone that night but does not believe she would have consented to having sex. She is, however, currently undecided whether she would be desirous of prosecution should the suspect be found. The victim told me that the clothes she had been wearing on 10-08-11 were still inside her residence unwashed. The victim remained at the hospital to be treated for STD's. I provided the victim with a counseling number should she feel the need to speak to someone [REDACTED]. I properly sealed the tampon inside an evidence envelope and took possession of it. I later recovered the clothing at the victim's residence and logged of the items into evidence.

On 12/26/11 at approx. 0747 hours I responded to [REDACTED] Tempe AZ in reference to a female who had been sexually assaulted in California and who wanted assistance with reporting it. Upon arrival I contacted [REDACTED] who was visibly upset and crying. [REDACTED] stated on 12/16/11 at approx. 0400 hours when she went to Hermosa Beach, California she was "raped" by an acquaintance [REDACTED] said she had not reported the incident originally because she didn't think anyone would believe her because she is a stripper, she met [REDACTED] on an online dating site called seeking arrangement.com and was intoxicated at the time. [REDACTED] also said she didn't want to ruin her friend [REDACTED] trip by calling the police.

[REDACTED] attempted to call the Hermosa Beach police department in my presence however [REDACTED] requested that Tempe police take a courtesy report and forward the report to them since [REDACTED] was no longer in California and did not plan to return. Hermosa police provided reference #116 for this incident.

I activated my digital audio recorder and conducted an interview with [REDACTED] this is a summary of that interview.

[REDACTED] stated approx. 5 weeks ago she was contacted via her profile on seeking arrangement.com by [REDACTED] stated she believed the website was set up to provide wealthy men and women with dates and people like herself signed up so that they could meet wealthy people and potentially be paid for these dates or possibly develop a "sugar daddy" type relationship. [REDACTED] did not view the website as a escort or cover for prostitution and she did not intend to have sex with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said over 5 weeks she texted with [REDACTED] approx. 10 times and they were just friendly text messages not sexual in nature. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] spoke about the possibility of meeting up sometime but had not made specific plans.

[REDACTED] said she and [REDACTED] made plans to go out to California to visit a friend since they were able to get free airline tickets. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] flew out to Long Beach California airport on the evening of 12/15/11 at approx. 2000 hours. Approx. eight hours before leaving they discovered their friend lived too far from the Long Beach airport to pick them up so [REDACTED] called [REDACTED] and told him she was going to be in town and asked if he wanted to get together and possibly pick her and [REDACTED] up from the airport. [REDACTED] agreed and [REDACTED] stated they never discussed any arrangement for where she would stay and [REDACTED] said she and [REDACTED] never had a conversation about money in exchange for her spending time with [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] picked them up from the airport in a white electric car unknown make or model possibly a Honda and this surprised [REDACTED] because on [REDACTED] profile for seeking arrangement.com he had posted a picture of a Phantom and made it seem as though it was his vehicle.

[REDACTED] stated he drove them to a white three story house on Hermosa Beach and she stated he told her it was a friends house and it used to be used on the show 90210. [REDACTED] said it was divided into what appeared to be three separate residences and they went into the middle one. [REDACTED] said it was

very sparsely furnished and it seemed strange to her. [REDACTED] said she and [REDACTED] took showers and got ready to go out with [REDACTED] and his male friend [REDACTED]. While getting ready [REDACTED] said she and [REDACTED] were drinking alcohol but [REDACTED] was not because he said he did not drink.

[REDACTED] stated they all went out to an unknown bar nearby where she and [REDACTED] drank some additional alcohol. [REDACTED] said she had approx. 7 mixed drinks containing liquor. [REDACTED] said they all went back to the house and she was surprised that [REDACTED] had put her stuff in his room instead of in a room with [REDACTED].

After taking out her hair extensions and climbing into bed with the intention of going to sleep [REDACTED] started kissing [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that she probably shouldn't call the police since she met [REDACTED] on an online dating website and [REDACTED] felt like [REDACTED] just wasn't taking her serious.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] slept together on the living room sofa and when they woke up the next day [REDACTED] said she still didn't know what to do. [REDACTED] apologized to [REDACTED] telling her "I'm sorry about last night you guys were really drunk". On 03-01-12 at approximately 0347 hours, Officer Gaona (#189) and I responded to [REDACTED] regarding a possible rape that occurred in Hermosa Beach on the above mentioned date. Upon my arrival I contacted [REDACTED] and her friend, [REDACTED] who were sitting on a couch in their apartment. As I entered into the apartment I immediately observed that both girls seemed visibly upset and they both appeared to have been crying. I contacted [REDACTED] and began my investigation. [REDACTED] told me that she went to Sharkeez (52 Pier Ave) with her friend [REDACTED] earlier in the night to have some drinks. While at the bar, [REDACTED] told me that she noticed a male subject [REDACTED] was there also with some of his friends. [REDACTED] told me that she met [REDACTED] one time approximately 6 months ago at a different bar in Hermosa Beach. [REDACTED] told me that she didn't want to go and talk with [REDACTED] because she was angry at him regarding an incident that occurred when they first met 6 months prior. [REDACTED] told me that she made a point to avoid talking to him when she was at Sharkeez with her friend. [REDACTED] told me that when the bar closed, all the bar patrons gathered outside the establishment on Pier Plaza, [REDACTED] told me that she looked for her friend but could not find her in the crowd of people. [REDACTED] then said [REDACTED] walked up to her and a brief conversation ensued. [REDACTED] essentially told [REDACTED] that she was looking for her friend [REDACTED] but couldn't find her. [REDACTED] also told [REDACTED] that she left her cell phone at home so she had no way to get in contact with [REDACTED]. At this point, [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] grabbed her and firmly guided her into the taxi cab and he got in next to her. [REDACTED] said she attempted to exit the cab through the opposite door but it was locked. [REDACTED] then told the cab driver that she wanted to get out of the cab but [REDACTED] told the driver, "she is fine let's just go, she's drunk." [REDACTED] then yelled to the driver, "no no no, I don't want to go...stop!" I then asked if she ever tried physically escape from the cab or yell for help and she said that she did not. [REDACTED] said she immediately started walking back towards Pier Ave as [REDACTED] was paying for the cab. As she was walking away [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] suddenly picked her up again and threw her over his shoulders. On Friday 05-18-12 at approximately 0249 hours, I (Cruz) and Officer Smuts (#187) were dispatched to [REDACTED] 261(a)PC rape report that had occurred in Hermosa Beach, but that Torrance PD had responded to. Upon arrival, we relieved Torrance PD and I contacted the victim [REDACTED] who told me the following:

[REDACTED] said they all began to hang out for a while and at approximately 2330 hours, [REDACTED] told her that she was going to go smoke a cigarette. [REDACTED] was then left inside of the bar with [REDACTED] for approximately 30 minutes. After 30 minutes, [REDACTED] said she became concerned and called [REDACTED] (using her cellular telephone) who answered the phone. But due to the loud music on her end of the cell phone, she could not hear [REDACTED] clearly so she hung up on her.

[REDACTED] left her friends behind at American Junkie and proceeded to Baja Sharkeez with the suspect and his friend between the approximate times of 0100 hours and 0115 hours. While at Baja Sharkeez, [REDACTED] believes that she drank one additional alcoholic beverage; however she could not recall exactly what that beverage was. [REDACTED] and the suspect consensually kissed each other while they were inside of Baja Sharkeez. [REDACTED] and the suspect left Sharkeez together between the approximate times of 0130 hours and 0200 hours. The suspect's friend did not join them. The suspect asked [REDACTED] to return to his residence with him. He implied that it was somewhere near the downtown area of Hermosa Beach; however he never specified his exact address. [REDACTED] told the suspect, "I'm not going to your place, but if you want we can sit on the beach."

[REDACTED] recalled walking westbound with the suspect on Pier Plaza and then turning southbound onto The Strand. She recalled walking in-front of a large blue motel which was consistent in size and appearance with the Sea Sprite Motel (1016 The Strand). They walked together westbound onto the beach in-front of this motel, and stopped approximately halfway between The Strand and the beach's waterline. They both sat down on the beach together, with the suspect sitting on [REDACTED] left side.

Upon sitting down on the beach, [REDACTED] and the suspect talked with each other for approximately 2 minutes. The suspect then placed his hands onto [REDACTED] shoulders and kissed her mouth area. According to [REDACTED] this kissing was consensual. The suspect directed [REDACTED] body into a laying position on the sand, and [REDACTED] willingly laid on her back while the suspect kissed her. It should be noted that the suspect was wearing pants, a t-shirt, and a vest; and that [REDACTED] was wearing a top/shirt, underwear, and shorts. The suspect placed himself on top of [REDACTED] by kneeling between her spread legs and then laying the front of his body on top of the front of her body. He placed the palms of his hands against her palms, interlaced his fingers with her corresponding fingers, and pinned her hands down to the sand on either side of her head. The suspect continued kissing [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said that this activity lasted for a few minutes, and that she still considered it consensual until the suspect slid one of his hands (unsure which one) into the top front portion of her shorts. The suspect's hand proceeded into [REDACTED] underwear and touched the exterior of her vaginal area. [REDACTED] said to the suspect, "No, I don't want to do this." The suspect did not reply to her statement. At about this time, the suspect inserted approximately 2 to 3 of his fingers into [REDACTED] vagina. The suspect's fingers remained inside of her vagina for approximately 1 to 2 minutes. During this event, the suspect slid his fingers back and forth inside of her vagina at a moderate pace.

[REDACTED] said the suspect then pulled down his pants while he was still in a kneeling position between her legs, and he exposed his erect penis (which appeared to be approximately 4 to 5 inches long). Due to the area's darkness, she did not observe any other obvious identifying characteristics associated with the suspect's genital area. The suspect then used one of his hands to push the crotch area of [REDACTED] shorts and underwear against her inner right thigh, thereby exposing her vaginal area. The suspect inserted his penis into [REDACTED] vagina. [REDACTED] did not observe the suspect place a condom onto his penis before penetrating her vagina. The suspect grabbed [REDACTED] wrists and pinned her arms slightly above her shoulders while he forced vaginal intercourse upon her [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] essentially stated the following; [REDACTED] stated that on 8-23-12 at approximately 2200 hours, [REDACTED] and a few of her friends arrived at Sharkeez (52 Pier Plaza in Hermosa Beach), where she had a total of three drinks. [REDACTED] stated, "I had no more than three Bacardi and Cokes, but I had not eaten anything that day so I was three sheets to the wind. At around eleven or eleven thirty, I left the bar alone and walked home [REDACTED]"

[REDACTED] then advised me that while looking through her iPhone this morning, she located a video recording of her being given a, "Piggy back ride" by an unknown white, male subject, back to her house. [REDACTED] believes she met this unknown subject while walking home and described him as a white male adult, between twenty five to thirty years old (NFI). [REDACTED] then held her iPhone out to me and played the video.

The video recording appeared as if the iPhone was video recording from [REDACTED] purse and at one point, it displayed the shadow of him carrying [REDACTED] over his shoulder. The video also recorded [REDACTED] and the male subject laughing, giggling, and making conversation about [REDACTED] shoes, and about walking home. [REDACTED] also located a picture of two shadows hugging in an alley that were taken either by her or by him. [REDACTED] stated, "I don't remember taking video or pictures of us. I was obviously three sheets to the wind and I take responsibility for that."

At the end of the video recording, it shows both of them arriving at [REDACTED] residence where they were greeted by [REDACTED] dogs. Both of them continue to laugh, giggle, and make conversation about the dogs. The video recording then comes to a stop as the iPhone is picked up by the subject, where it shows a quick glance of his face and it shows him wearing a dark colored T-shirt and hat.

After arriving home, [REDACTED] claims not to have any recollection of anything, but she located a text message in her iPhone to her friend [REDACTED] at 0059 hours (8-24-12), where she texted him that she was home and was ready to go to bed. [REDACTED] is one of her friends that was with her at Sharkeez. [REDACTED] stated, "I don't remember anything. I just remember waking up at four in the morning and noticed that I was wearing an old red T-shirt of mine but with no undergarments. As I woke up, I noticed that I was alone in my bed and that my front door was wide open. As I stood up to close my door, I looked out the window and noticed that the Lexus was missing."

[REDACTED] stated that she immediately texted a few of her friends to ask if any of them had taken the Lexus, but all of them said no. At that point, [REDACTED] went back to sleep and a few hours later she woke up and went to work. [REDACTED] stated, "I was supposed to be at work at 730, but I was running late and made it at eight o'clock. Once at work, I felt off and sick. I just knew something was wrong, like if I had sex. After feeling sick, I went home and that's when I called you to report the car stolen." Refer to stolen vehicle report under DR#12- [REDACTED] for further details and statements. [REDACTED] believes this unknown male subject left her house in between midnight and four (4AM) after they had sex, taking the keys to the Lexus that were sitting on top of her dining table and took the car without her permission.

The Lexus is a car she is taking care of for her friend [REDACTED], who is out of town, which was last seen parked in front of her house [REDACTED] at the time she arrived home from the bar.

When I asked [REDACTED] why she had failed to mention this incident to me when I took the stolen report, she stated being embarrassed and was giving it some time to process all and for the vehicle to be located. After giving it some thought, she became worried about contracting a sexually transmitted disease (STD), and responded to Beach Cities Medical Center to receive STD testing. Once at the center, due to her not being conscious during the possible act of sexual intercourse, we were contacted to take a rape report.

At the time, [REDACTED] was more concerned with contracting an STD than reporting the incident to the authorities. She claimed to be embarrassed and was unsure of being desirous of any prosecution. [REDACTED] stated, "I just want the car back".

Source: On 12-01-12 at approximately 2222 hours I was dispatched to [REDACTED] CA for a P.C. 261 (Rape) call.

Investigation: I arrived at [REDACTED] and contacted several [REDACTED] Fireman who were leaving the residence. The fireman told me they had been summoned to the scene to examine the victim of a rape. The [REDACTED] fire personnel stated that the victim did not have life threatening injuries.

I next contacted the two [REDACTED] Police officers who had originally been summoned to the scene to take the rape report. I was informed by the [REDACTED] officers that they had spoken with the victim [REDACTED] and discovered the incident had occurred in the City of Hermosa Beach. The [REDACTED] Officers briefed me on the situation and turned the investigation over to me.

The victim [REDACTED] was sitting on a loveseat in the living room of her mother's [REDACTED] home weeping. [REDACTED] was wearing a gray, long sleeved shirt, blue jeans and pink half socks. [REDACTED] clothes appeared clean and dry. [REDACTED] socks, however, appeared to be wet and somewhat dirty. [REDACTED] hair was dry and relatively

well kept. [REDACTED] had 3x5 inch green and black bruise below her right cheekbone. At the time I observed the bruising on [REDACTED] cheek there was moderate swelling. [REDACTED] did not appear to be under the influence of drugs and or alcohol.

The victim's mother [REDACTED] and her brother [REDACTED] were also in the living room. I first spoke with [REDACTED]

Involved Party 1, [REDACTED] explained that on 12-01-12 at approximately 1700 hours her daughter [REDACTED] left [REDACTED] home after having been at the house for several hours relaxing and talking. When [REDACTED] left, she told [REDACTED] that she would return shortly so she [REDACTED] could have dinner with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] told me that at approximately 2150 hours on the aforementioned date, she was standing in the kitchen of her home preparing dinner when she heard the front door open. [REDACTED] then heard [REDACTED] explain to [REDACTED] that she had been raped. [REDACTED] proceeded to the front door and observed [REDACTED] lying on the floor crying while [REDACTED] stood by her. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] was distraught and could only state that she had been raped. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] then brought [REDACTED] to the living room and had her sit on a loveseat while [REDACTED] phoned the police.

Involved Party 2, [REDACTED] told me that he was standing in the living room of his mother's house at approximately 2150 hours when he heard the front door open. [REDACTED] turned to see who was at the door and observed [REDACTED] walk into the house from the front door, step a few feet into the doorway, drop her skateboard and collapse on the floor crying. When [REDACTED] approached [REDACTED] to render her aid and determine what had occurred, [REDACTED] told him [REDACTED] she had been raped. [REDACTED] and his mother then walked [REDACTED] to a loveseat located in the living room and called the police.

Victim, [REDACTED] I spoke with [REDACTED] in the living room of her mother's home. [REDACTED] was visibly distraught and crying. At the time of the interview, [REDACTED] mother sat beside her on a loveseat located in the living room. [REDACTED] clung to her mother for the length of the interview.

[REDACTED] told me, in essence, the following: On 12-01-12 at approximately 1700 hours she left her mother's home on [REDACTED] and went to the apartment/room she shares with her boyfriend [REDACTED] at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told me she stayed at her apartment/room alone until approximately 2000 hours at which time she left and skateboarded to the Hermosa Beach Pier to "hang-out." [REDACTED] told me she went to the Pier by herself, as she often does, to skateboard and walk around. [REDACTED] said that between 2000 and 2100 hours she was walking on The Strand somewhere north of the Pier when an unknown suspect threw a cloth bag over her head from behind and punched her in the right side of her face. [REDACTED] said that after being punched, she felt two persons (suspects), one on either side of her, grab her arms and drag her a short distance. While being dragged [REDACTED] heard one of the suspects tell her to be quiet. [REDACTED] identified the voice as male and said she kept silent because she was afraid she would be harmed if she did not obey.

After being dragged a short distance she was laid on her back on concrete and heard one of the suspects state, "Hold her down," at which time her arms were held down at her sides. [REDACTED] said that a second suspect then removed her shoes and pulled at the fly area of her jeans so aggressively that they (the jeans) tore. Once the fly of her jeans had been torn open the suspect removed them (the jeans). [REDACTED] stated she was not wearing panties at the time of the assault. Once the suspect removed her jeans, he laid on top of her and penetrated her vagina with his penis.

I asked [REDACTED] if at the time her vagina was penetrated by the suspect's penis she still had the cloth bag on her head. [REDACTED] stated the cloth bag was on her head until the suspects fled the scene. I asked [REDACTED] how she knew it was the assailant's penis that penetrated her vagina since she was unable to see. [REDACTED] told me that she did not see the suspect put his penis in her vagina but was able to recognize what was occurring by his positioning and actions. According to [REDACTED], the suspect laid on top of her and then inserted his penis in her vagina. The suspect then repeatedly thrust his penis in her stopping a short time later [REDACTED] was unable to identify whether the suspect was wearing a condom or if he ejaculated.

Shortly after the suspect removed his penis from her vagina the suspect that had been pinning her arms to the

## Narrative

On Friday 12-7-12 at approximately 1535 hours, I (Droz) was dispatched to UCLA Santa Monica Hospital (1250 16th Street, Santa Monica) regarding a rape report.

I arrived at the hospital at approximately 1628 hours and contacted the reporting party (a rape crisis counselor named [REDACTED] who subsequently introduced me to the victim [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] did not initially want to report the following incident to the police; however [REDACTED] consensually provided me with the following statement after I informed her that she could terminate the interview at any time. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] roommate [REDACTED] were present during the following interview. The interview was conducted inside of an office located at the hospital's SART examination center.

[REDACTED] told me that on the evening of 12-6-12, she and her roommate [REDACTED] boarded a party bus with approximately 30 of their fellow [REDACTED] students. Prior to arriving in Hermosa Beach, [REDACTED] consumed 5 shots of vodka. She said that she felt intoxicated upon arriving in Hermosa Beach.

At approximately 2230 hours, [REDACTED] and her roommate arrived in Hermosa Beach and proceeded directly to Watermans (22 Pier Plaza). While at Watermans, [REDACTED] drank one gin and tonic alcoholic beverage. Based on [REDACTED] high level of alcohol intoxication while inside of Watermans, she had difficulty articulating specific details regarding the proceeding series of events.

[REDACTED] remembered being inside of the customer serving area of Watermans for an unspecified amount of time. She next remembered being inside of what appeared to be a kitchen. She was not sure if this kitchen was associated with Watermans or another nearby establishment. [REDACTED] recalled that there was a stainless steel table inside of this kitchen area. She was unable to recall what had prompted her to enter the kitchen. [REDACTED] remembered the suspect being in the kitchen with her; however she did not recall when or where she first met him. She believes there may have been two other males also in the kitchen; however she was not sure if they were actually there, or if they were products of a confused recollection due to her high level of alcohol intoxication.

On Sunday 1-13-13 at approximately 1110 hours, I (Dove) was dispatched to the HBPD front lobby regarding a sexual assault report.

I contacted the victim [REDACTED] [REDACTED] told me that on 1-12-13 at approximately 1900 hours, she arrived at her friend's residence which is located in the city of Inglewood near the intersection of Century Boulevard and Hawthorne Boulevard. Her friend is named [REDACTED] and friend [REDACTED]. Prior to leaving [REDACTED] residence, [REDACTED] consumed two mixed alcoholic beverages consisting of Jaeger Meister alcohol and Rockstar soda. Between the approximate times of 2200 hours and 2230 hours, [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] left [REDACTED] residence. [REDACTED] did not travel with them.

They arrived in the city of Manhattan Beach at approximately 2300 hours and proceeded to The Strand bar (117 Manhattan Beach Blvd.) After arriving at the above location, [REDACTED] consumed two additional Jaeger Meister and Rockstar alcoholic beverages. She did not recall exactly how long she was inside of the above location. [REDACTED] recalled leaving [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] somewhere inside of the bar, and proceeding alone to the bar's serving area. She remembered feeling like she was under the influence of alcohol at this time. [REDACTED] last memory was being in the bar's dance floor area and dancing with an unidentified male [REDACTED] was unable to describe this male, and she did not recall if he was in any way affiliated with the suspect who is later described in this report.

[REDACTED] did not recall leaving the above location or traveling to any additional locations with any additional subjects.

[REDACTED] next remembered waking up in a hotel room. She felt heavily intoxicated at this time, and had no recollection of how or why she had proceeded to this location. [REDACTED] was laying on her back; she was wearing a bra, and was not wearing any underwear. The suspect was on top of her and facing her. She did not recall being restrained or battered by the suspect. [REDACTED] felt the sensation of the suspect's penis moving inside of her vagina; and realized that he was having vaginal intercourse with her. [REDACTED] also recalled the suspect kissing her mouth several times. Shortly after [REDACTED] realized that vaginal intercourse was occurring, she said to the suspect, "I don't want to be here, I don't know where I'm at." She then said to him, "I can't do this;" and she used both of her hands to push his chest. The suspect immediately stopped having intercourse with [REDACTED] and said to her, "Okay, I'll get you a cab." [REDACTED] did not observe the suspect's penis, nor did she remember if the suspect used a condom. She

also did not know if the suspect ejaculated during their intercourse. The above vaginal intercourse lasted less than a minute, and [REDACTED] did not complain of pain to any portions of her body (including her vagina or anus).

[REDACTED] also realized there was vomit in her hair, and she believed that she might have vomited while she was unconscious. She immediately walked to the restroom and washed her face. [REDACTED] then re-dressed, and left the hotel room while being escorted by the suspect. [REDACTED] and the suspect took an elevator down to the hotel's front lobby and waited for a taxi. Although she was not completely sure what time the taxi arrived, she believed that at approximately 0300 hours, a yellow and blue colored taxi (unknown which taxi company) arrived at the hotel to pick her up. The suspect was last observed by [REDACTED] standing near the hotel's front counter.

[REDACTED] confirmed that she had left "Hotel Hermosa" (2515 Pacific Coast Highway); however, she was not sure which floor, or which room she had been inside of. [REDACTED] only recalled walking down a hallway, and then taking an elevator down to the hotel's lobby (indicating that the suspect's room had been above the hotel's first level).

[REDACTED] described the suspect as a male with tan skin, who was possibly Hispanic, 27 to 35 years old, approximately 5'10 to 6 feet tall, with short brown colored hair, and unknown colored eyes. She did not observe the suspect to have any facial hair, tattoos, or piercings. It was difficult for [REDACTED] to articulate what the suspect was wearing; however, she believed he was wearing pants (unknown colored) and a shirt (unknown colored).

[REDACTED] took a taxi to back [REDACTED] residence and arrived there at an unknown time. She had a receipt from the taxi ride for \$30 which indicated a possible reference number [REDACTED] associated with the transaction, but did not specifically list a taxi cab company (see photograph). [REDACTED] remembered waking up at [REDACTED] residence at approximately 0630 hours. She went back to sleep, woke up again at approximately 0730 hours, and drove back to her residence shortly thereafter. [REDACTED] arrived back to her residence at approximately 0800 hours.

It should be noted that [REDACTED] had left her purse and cell phone inside of [REDACTED] vehicle prior to entering The Strand bar. The following morning, upon being reunited with her purse and cell phone, [REDACTED] observed a text message from [REDACTED] which was sent at approximately 0119 hours, and which stated, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] believed that this text message indicated that she had been separated from [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] prior to 0119 hours.

[REDACTED] told me that she requested police involvement to assist her with obtaining the above SART examination. [REDACTED] believed that she might be desirous of prosecution against the suspect; however she was not sure if she was at the time of our interview.

I additionally photographed [REDACTED] prior to her examination to assist investigators with identifying her clothing and physical appearance in any possible surveillance video footage which might be located (all photographs were later downloaded into the HBPD computer system under the same report number).

I then drove [REDACTED] to the SART examination center located at [REDACTED] in the city of Torrance where I introduced her to SART Nurse [REDACTED]. I additionally introduced [REDACTED] to a rape crisis counselor named, [REDACTED]. While in the presence of the rape crisis counselor, I provided [REDACTED] with a Marsy's Card (victim bill of rights pamphlet) as well as this report number.

I was present for the SART interview conducted by SART [REDACTED]. During this interview, [REDACTED] did not complain of any additional pain or injuries to her person, and she did not report any additional acts of sexual assault which might have occurred during the above incident. [REDACTED] then underwent a SART examination.

After [REDACTED] underwent her SART examination, I drove her back to the HBPD, where we arrived at approximately 1635 hours.

I then proceeded to the Hotel Hermosa and contacted an employee at the front desk who verbally identified himself as [REDACTED]. I informed [REDACTED] that I was searching for a potential guest who might have stayed at the hotel's second or third story around 0300 hours on the date of this report (1-13-13). [REDACTED] said that an employee named [REDACTED] had been working at that time. [REDACTED] additionally said that he was unable to access the hotel's video surveillance system because only the hotel's management access to it; and that it could be accessed after 0800 hours the following morning (1-14-13). [REDACTED] was however, able to access the hotel's computer system, he then informed me about guests who stayed on the hotel's second and third story

[REDACTED] was also able to narrow down which males had checked out of the hotel on the date of this report). The hotel's computer system had digital photographs of the guests which had been taken from the guests' driver's licenses and identification cards when they checked in. While reviewing these photographs with [REDACTED] I identified several hotel guests which exhibited similar physical traits to the suspect's physical description. One of these guests ([REDACTED]) checked into the hotel on 1-13-13 at approximately 0238 hours, and checked out of the hotel later that day at approximately 0853 hours. See attached photocopies of the guest's registration information (no photographs were provided on these computer printouts).

I responded back to the SART center and was provided with the following items by SART [REDACTED] a SART kit, a SART urine sample, a SART blood sample, a SART forensic medical report, a bag containing clothing, and a bag containing a towel. I booked the above items into the HBPD property room (see attached property report for additional details).

SART [REDACTED] additionally told me that while performing the above examination on [REDACTED] she observed the following: bruising on both of the victim's knees, bruising and tenderness on the victim's left forearm, a Woods Lamp reaction on the victim's left hip (indicating possible saliva or semen contact on that area), no anal or vaginal tearing (although her interior vaginal walls were red and tender), and no toluidine blue dye uptake on the victim's vaginal or anal areas (indicating that there were no tears/abrasions in either of those two areas).

The above investigation was recorded with a digital audio recorder and the audio files were later downloaded into the HBPD computer system under corresponding date and time stamps.

On 1/30/13 at approximately 1344 hours, I, Officer Donahue, was dispatched to the HBPD lobby in reference to a 288 PC. I contacted the reporting party, [REDACTED] and she told me the following:

On 1/10/13, [REDACTED] drove to [REDACTED] in Harbor City California to pick up a friend named [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told me that she drove [REDACTED] and herself to Hermosa Beach. Upon arriving in Hermosa Beach, [REDACTED] parked in the public parking lot located off of 2nd Street and Pacific Coast Highway. At approximately 2200 hours, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] proceeded to walk to American Junkie located at 68 Pier Plaza.

While at American Junkie, [REDACTED] told me that [REDACTED] wanted her to drink alcohol. [REDACTED] said she did not want to but [REDACTED] said "No, you have to drink with me." She complied and consumed one alcoholic beverage. The beverage was called a Victoria's Secret. She said the only time she left her drink alone was when she went to the bathroom. Upon returning to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] did not consume anymore of her alcoholic beverage. [REDACTED] consumed two beers while at American Junkie. [REDACTED] paid for [REDACTED] drink.

At approximately 0000 hours on 1/11/13, [REDACTED] was still at American Junkie and was feeling tipsy. She said she did not feel safe to drive. On Tuesday 3-19-13 at approximately 2043 hours, I (Ofc. Dove #191) was dispatched to the HBPD front lobby reference a rape report. Upon arrival, I contacted the victim [REDACTED], who was accompanied by a female friend. [REDACTED] told me the following:

On 3-17-13 at approximately 1400 hours, [REDACTED] arrived at her cousin's [REDACTED] residence located in the City of South Gate for the celebration of St. Patrick's Day. [REDACTED] drove her white, 4-door, Toyota Camry to her friends, [REDACTED] residence (possibly located in the South Gate) to pick him up. The three then arrived in Hermosa Beach at approximately 1500 hours. [REDACTED] then parked her vehicle in a designated parking space located in lot-A (adjacent to 11th Street and Hermosa Ave). They then walked to the front entrance of Baja Sharkeez Bar (52 Pier Plaza) and entered the establishment.

While at Sharkeez, [REDACTED] stated that she, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] sat down at the bar area of the restaurant and ordered alcoholic beverages. [REDACTED] stated that she had consumed an unknown amount of vodka and tonic alcoholic beverages. She received her drinks directly from the bartender. However, there was one instance where an unknown male bought her a "shot" of an unknown type of alcoholic beverage. [REDACTED] stated she observed the bartender pour the shot into the shot glass. I asked [REDACTED] if she felt as though she had been drugged. [REDACTED] told me "no." [REDACTED] felt that she had consumed entirely too much alcohol at Sharkeez.

[REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] exited Sharkeez from the front entrance. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] sat down on a nearby concrete bench with an unknown female and took a photograph with [REDACTED] cellphone (see evidence photograph). ## NOTIFICATION:

On Sunday 9-1-13 at approximately 1220 hours, I (Droz) was dispatched to the HBPD front lobby regarding a rape report.

I contacted the victim [REDACTED] a friend of hers who had observed [REDACTED] interacting with the suspect [REDACTED] and an uninvolved friend [REDACTED].

I conducted a preliminary interview of [REDACTED] which led me to believe that she might have been the victim of a sexual assault; and based upon this preliminary interview, I contacted a Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) nurse and a YWCA rape crisis counselor.

I then drove [REDACTED] to the SART examination center located at 20911 Earl Street, Torrance, CA. At [REDACTED] request, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] followed us to the SART center so that they could provide her with support.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] provided me with the following statements.

## WITNESS [REDACTED] STATEMENT:

[REDACTED] told me that on 8-31-13 between the approximate times of 1800 hours and 2000 hours [REDACTED] saw [REDACTED] wearing a bikini. She observed that [REDACTED] did not appear to have any bruises on her body.

Later that evening at approximately 2130 hours, while inside of [REDACTED] residence, [REDACTED], and a male friend of theirs named [REDACTED] each drank two shots of Jameson whiskey. The above three subjects took a taxi to Hermosa Beach, where they arrived at approximately 2200 hours. They proceeded to the upstairs patio of Hennessey's Tavern (8 Pier Avenue). While at this location, [REDACTED] consumed a partial glass of a Long Island Iced Tea (alcoholic beverage), [REDACTED] consumed a "Sweet Tea Vodka," and [REDACTED] consumed a Coors light beer. The three subjects temporarily walked down to the ground level of the bar to watch a band, and then returned to the upstairs patio area. The suspect approached [REDACTED] and repeatedly attempted to converse with her. The suspect then purchased an alcoholic beverage for [REDACTED] from the bar's upstairs bar area and appeared to aggressively "hover" around her.

[REDACTED] and the suspect left Hennessey's Tavern together at approximately 1045 hours. [REDACTED] heard the suspect repeatedly tell [REDACTED], "Come home with me." She also repeatedly heard [REDACTED] tell the suspect, "I don't want to come home with you," each time he posed that request. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] entered Baja Sharkeez (52 Pier Avenue) at approximately 2245 hours so that they could use the restroom at that location. [REDACTED] last saw [REDACTED] standing on Pier Plaza in-front of Baja Sharkeez next to the suspect at that time. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] returned to the front of Baja Sharkeez at approximately 2300 hours and discovered that [REDACTED] and the suspect were no longer there. [REDACTED] believed that [REDACTED] had voluntarily left the location with the suspect.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] left Hermosa Beach together in a taxi and returned to [REDACTED] residence. [REDACTED] called [REDACTED] cell-phone 3 times (at 2307 hours, 2315 hours, and 2343 hours) and only heard ringing with no answer. She also sent [REDACTED] approximately 10 text messages, and did not receive any responses. While [REDACTED] was present, [REDACTED] received a telephone call from [REDACTED] between the approximate times of 0001 hours and 0030 hours. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] "I'm okay; I'm at his hotel room."

[REDACTED] provided a physical description of the suspect (see the suspect page for additional details); and told me that she believed she would be able to recognize him if she ever saw him again.

[REDACTED] also said that [REDACTED] had been wearing a dark green colored T-shirt, black colored shorts, black colored high-heeled shoes, as well as a flower patterned choker style necklace around her neck (this clothing description, as well as photographs I later took of [REDACTED] with a digital camera, were provided to help identify [REDACTED] in any potential surveillance videos which might be located).
