On 12-23-07 at approx. 1847 hours, Officer Brunn and I were dispatched to [REDACTED] Herondo Ave apartment [REDACTED] regarding a stabbing that just occurred. While we were responding dispatch advised all of the responding units that the possible suspect lived in apartment [REDACTED]

Observations / Investigation:

Upon arrival, Officer Brunn and I located a male subject who was later identified as [REDACTED] standing in the hallway area near apartment [REDACTED]. I saw that Lee was bleeding and the blood was coming from his right leg. It appeared to be a stab wound and I observed a lot of blood in the area of where Lee was standing. At this point, I had Lee sit down and advised via radio to have the HBPD paramedics come to Lee's location for treatment. A few seconds later a female with blonde hair contacted us and said, "The male and female you are looking for ran this way." Officer Brunn and I entered the southwest parking structure where these alleged suspects were last seen and we searched all the levels of the parking structure but were met with negative results.

At this point, dispatch notified all the units at the scene that they had a possible suspect on the phone advising them that he needed medical attention. After a few minutes I acquired the suspect's cell phone number from dispatch [REDACTED] and was told that the possible suspect's name was [REDACTED]. I called the number and spoke with a male who identified himself as [REDACTED] and he told me that he needed medical attention because he was stabbed. [REDACTED] told me that he had a cut on his thumb and that he was looking for a hospital. I asked him where he was at and he told me that he was at the 405 freeway and Venice Boulevard. I asked him what he was driving and he told me that he was driving a black BMW. I told him to pull over and that I would meet him there. Officer Brunn and I started heading to [REDACTED] location and while we were responding, I lost cell phone communication with [REDACTED].

I called [REDACTED] again and [REDACTED] answered and told me that he was in the parking lot of Del Amo Sports (Marine Ave and the 405 freeway). We began heading in that direction and while I was speaking with [REDACTED] he advised me that he was leaving the parking lot and that he was on the 405 south freeway. I told [REDACTED] to get off on Rosecrans Ave and to go W/B towards Manhattan Beach. I then advised him to pull into the shopping center parking lot at the southwest corner of Aviation Blvd and Rosecrans Avenue. [REDACTED] told me that he was in the shopping center in front of Old Navy and that he saw a police car. I advised him to flag the police car down and [REDACTED] did. MBPD Officer Thompson was the officer that was flagged down by [REDACTED]. Officer Brunn and I arrived a few minutes later and I spoke with [REDACTED] while Officer Brunn spoke with [REDACTED] female passenger who was later identified as [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] told me that he lived at [REDACTED] in apartment [REDACTED] and that he was confronted inside his apartment. [REDACTED] said that he was acting like "Chris Hanson" from the MSNBC television show "Catching a Child Predator," and invited a male Asian to his apartment. [REDACTED] advised that he was on his computer pretending to be a 14-year-old girl. [REDACTED] said that he was exchanging e-mails with different people, so that he could trick them into believing that he was a 14-year-old girl so he could "bust" male adults. He advised that during this particular incident he told an unknown person to come to his apartment with marijuana and that he would have sex with them. [REDACTED] said that an Asian male showed up at his apartment and he invited him inside. [REDACTED] told me that the male Asian placed some marijuana on his table and that he was going to purchase the marijuana from the male Asian. [REDACTED] also said that his girlfriend [REDACTED] was inside the apartment with him during the contact with this unknown Asian male. [REDACTED] advised me that while all three of them were inside the apartment that the Asian male pulled out a knife and a wrestling match ensued over the knife. [REDACTED] said that during the scuffle he received a cut on his right thumb and that he did not know if the male Asian received any injuries. I asked [REDACTED] where the Asian male went after the altercation and [REDACTED] said he didn't know.

I asked [REDACTED] if he would give officers permission to enter his apartment and he said "Of course go ahead and search." I did not have a search consent form with me so I borrowed one from an El Segundo officer and read the form to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said that he understood the form and signed it in my presence.

Arrest:

Based on the above information, I placed [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] under arrest for 245 (a)(1) PC

(assault with a deadly weapon) and 182 (a)(1) PC (conspiracy). Once in custody, [REDACTED] told me that she was 19-years-old but it was discovered that she was only 17-years-old. I asked her why she lied and she apologized and told me that she would not lie anymore.

Additional:

Once [REDACTED] and Lee were interviewed by the detectives [REDACTED] was booked for 245(a)(1) PC, 211 PC, and 182(a)(1) PC. [REDACTED] was booked for 602 WIC 211 PC and 602 WIC 182 (a)(1) PC. Lee was the victim during this incident and was being treated at Little Company of Mary hospital at the time of this report.

While at the HBPD jail, paramedics treated [REDACTED] right thumb and the paramedics advised me that the cut on [REDACTED] thumb appeared to be an old injury that got infected.

Narrative

On 12/23/07 at approximately 1900 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] Herondo Street to assist patrol Officers who were investigating a crime scene. When I arrived on scene, I noticed a large amount of blood on the floor and walls of the hallway just outside apartment [REDACTED] and the door of the apartment also had a substantial amount of blood on it as well. At the time of my arrival no Officer had entered [REDACTED] or confirmed the interior of the apartment did not contain any additional victims who may have been injured or dying. Due to the large amount of blood outside of [REDACTED] the limited and unreliable information regarding the number of possible victims, and the possibility of additional undiscovered victims being concealed within [REDACTED] I requested that patrol Officers force entry into the apartment. In compliance with my request, Sgt Turek, Officer Faulk, Officer Droz, Det Lewis, and I then forced entry into the apartment. We conducted a sweep of the apartment searching any areas where a person could be concealed. After determining that no addition victims were present we retreated from the apartment and shut the door.

A short time later suspect [REDACTED] was contacted by Officer Sellan in the city of Manhattan Beach. Via radio it was requested that Sellan ask [REDACTED] for permission to search his apartment and [REDACTED] gave his consent (see report by Officer Sellan). Det Scheid, Det Lewis, Lt Bohlin, and I then entered [REDACTED] residence [REDACTED] to conduct a search for evidence. During the search we recovered a large folding "Buck" knife with what appeared to be blood and tissue residue on the blade and handle, a laptop computer, couch cushions with blood spots, a cell phone, a female's purse containing items belonging to suspect [REDACTED] suspect [REDACTED] identification and wallet, a bedspread with blood, a black jacket with what appeared to be blood on it, a pink shirt with blood on it, two different containers of Marijuana, a Buck knife sheath, and

a 3-pack of condoms. The laptop computer was collected in a way to preserve all data to allow for a forensic review of data history and use of the laptop. After recovering the above listed property the residence was vacated and secured.

After securing the apartment, Lt Bohlin and I returned to the hallway / elevator area and recovered the victim's pants that had been cutoff by rescue personnel during treatment. The pants were photographed and then collected.

I attempted to contact several neighbors at surrounding residences where the blood trails had been found. I noticed a large amount of blood in front of apartment [REDACTED] and I was able to contact the resident of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] who had direct contact with the victim after he was stabbed. [REDACTED] stated that he was in his residence when he heard the fire alarm for the complex ringing. [REDACTED] stated that he opened his door to look out to see what was happening and he saw a male subject passing by his door. The male subject, later identified as [REDACTED] Lee, stopped and asked [REDACTED] for help. [REDACTED] stated that Lee was on a cell phone with a 911 emergency dispatch operator and did not know how to describe his location to the emergency operator. [REDACTED] stated that Lee handed him the cell phone and he [REDACTED] was able to inform the dispatch operator of the correct location. [REDACTED] gave Lee his phone back and Lee began to walk back toward the area of the elevator. [REDACTED] stated that he noticed Lee was bleeding badly from his leg and seemed like he was "out of it" as he walked away.

After the crime scene was broken down I returned to the Hermosa Beach Police station and recovered suspect [REDACTED] clothing from him. The clothing was booked into evidence.

Summary Narrative

ASSIGNMENT/ARRIVAL

On 12-23-2007 at about 1847 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] Herondo Street in reference to a stabbing that had occurred at that location. Dispatch advised that one of the units/apartments involved in the incident was [REDACTED]. Initial broadcast led me to believe that the suspect involved in the crime resided at unit [REDACTED]. Upon arrival, I responded directly to unit [REDACTED] where I immediately observed red stains on the carpet in the hallway in front of unit [REDACTED]. The stains appeared to be fresh/wet and appeared to resemble stains of smeared blood. At this time, I was approached by a subject who told me that he lived in unit [REDACTED] and that he had dialed "911" to report the activation of the facilities fire alarm and to report that someone had been stabbed.

WITNESS STATEMENT

The witness was identified by California driver license as [REDACTED].

I asked [REDACTED] to tell me what he had observed. [REDACTED] told me that he was inside of his apartment when he heard the activation of the fire alarm. [REDACTED] told me that he opened his front door and saw a subject lying on the ground. [REDACTED] told me that the subject handed him a cell phone and asked him to call "911." [REDACTED] told me that the subject told him that he had been stabbed. [REDACTED] said that the subject was hysterical and bleeding profusely from his leg. [REDACTED] said that the subject then grabbed the phone from him before he was able to dial '911'. [REDACTED] said that the subject then ran down the hallway in a Northerly direction and out of view. [REDACTED] told me that he called "911" to report what he had witnessed. [REDACTED] said that he walked down the hallway to where he last seen the subject at which time he encountered the subject and police.

OBSERVATIONS

As mentioned, I observed blood stains on the floor/carpet in front of unit [REDACTED]. I saw a trail of blood leading down the hallway, Northerly direction, away from [REDACTED]. I followed the blood trail and found that they led to a subject who had a stab wound to his right leg. At this point, the subject had been contacted by the police and was being treated by paramedics.

INVESTIGATION: According to Detective Lewis-160 (supervisor), interviews with suspects [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and victim Lee revealed the following:

Suspects [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] lured victim Lee to their residence (via Internet) at [REDACTED] Herondo [REDACTED] in a ruse to have sex with suspect [REDACTED] (minor).

Suspect [REDACTED] removed the victim's keys and cellular phone from his pants pockets as suspect [REDACTED] held a knife to victim Lee's neck. [REDACTED] then told victim Lee to remove his pants. Victim Lee was then in fear of possible mayhem or other bodily injuries. Victim Lee resisted and a struggle for the knife ensued. During the altercation, victim Lee was stabbed by [REDACTED] in the right leg (hamstring area). Victim Lee fled the apartment and pulled the fire alarm and summoned assistance from a resident of another apartment, who dialed 911.

Suspects [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] then fled the apartment fearing pending police contact.

Supervising Detective Lewis-160 told me that suspect [REDACTED] made full admonitions to details in the above scenario.

Summary Narrative

HBPD officers responded to a location regarding an assault with a deadly weapon. During their investigation, officers discovered the location of a possible suspect's residence; and they entered that residence.

Narrative

On 12-23-07 at 1847 hours, I (Droz) responded to Herondo Street regarding a 245 PC assault with a deadly weapon which had just occurred. I arrived on scene and observed the victim, Lee who was sitting down in a 3rd story hallway inside of the apartment complex. I observed a trail of bloody footprints which led to apartment Officer Sellan #168 then advised me to stand guard at the front door of the above unit to ensure that no-one entered or exited it.

It should be known that at approximately 1938 hours, [redacted] was detained for investigation in the vicinity of [redacted] in the city of [redacted]

Based on the fact that the above residence contained a potential crime scene as well as possible unknown or undetected victims related to the violent felony which had just occurred, a decision was made to force entry to conduct a quick sweep of its interior to determine if any outstanding victims were concealed there.

At approximately 1944 hours, Sgt. Turek #102, Detective Lewis #160, Detective Saylor #164, Officer Faulk #175, and I attempted to enter apartment [redacted]. The unit's front door was knocked on several times and an announcement was made that we were HBPD officers. We heard no response from any possible subject(s) inside of the residence. I attempted to use a universal door key which had been provided by an employee of the apartment building; however this key did not work. Based on the exigency of the situation, I used my right foot to kick in the residence's front door.

The above HBPD officers and I entered the apartment and concluded that no outstanding suspects were inside of it. HBPD officers then exited the apartment.

Approximately five minutes after HBPD officers exited apartment [REDACTED], [REDACTED] then gave his permission for a search of his apartment [REDACTED]. See Officer Sellan's crime report for additional details of [REDACTED] permission to search.

HBPD officers then reentered the above apartment and proceeded with a criminal investigation regarding the above 245 PC. See Officer Sellan's crime report as well as additional supplemental reports for details of the above investigation.

Narrative

On 12/23/07 at 2200 hours, I drove to Little Company of Mary Hospital to interview [REDACTED] Lee, [REDACTED]. He was stabbed in the right rear hamstring with a knife during a struggle with suspect [REDACTED].

Lee told me that he met a girl on line at about 1630 hours on the above listed date. He said that he and the girl discussed sex and that she was home alone. He said that she was the one that brought up sex first. He said that he asked her how old she was and she told him, "That it doesn't matter".

See all attached e-mails from Lee's account [REDACTED] Password to account [REDACTED]

Lee told me that he and the girl he was talking to at [REDACTED] came to the understanding that she would drive to his location at [REDACTED] in [REDACTED]. He said that he waited about one hour and she never came to pick him up. He said she called him and told him that he should come to Hermosa where she was. He said that he got into his car and drove to Hermosa. She called him numerous times on his updates of his location. She told him that she would be waiting for him outside her location at [REDACTED] Herondo, wearing a black dress with blond hair. I asked him what name he was calling her. He said that on the cell phone calls during his drive he was calling her, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. He said that when he got closer he called her cell number [REDACTED] and told her that he was pulling up to the front of her location.

He said he immediately saw a female that matched her description. He exited his vehicle and they walked to her apartment, [REDACTED] and the front entrance door was wide open. He said when they entered her apartment she closed the door behind them. He said that he sat on the couch and moments later the entrance door opened up and suspect [REDACTED] walked through the front door in rage and yelling at him. He said that [REDACTED] identified himself as a police officer and was yelling at him calling him a child molester. He said that suspect [REDACTED] had a knife in his right hand and while yelling at him, [REDACTED] jumped on his lap and place the knife next to his neck and forehead. [REDACTED] told him to take his pants off and at that moment he felt and saw the female,

later identified as suspect [REDACTED] reach into his front pockets and pulled his phone and keys out.

Lee said at that moment he feared that his [REDACTED] (penis) might get cut off. He said that he fought and threw suspect [REDACTED] off of him to the floor. He said that he had [REDACTED] in a "choke hold" and explained how [REDACTED] was on all fours and he (Lee) was on [REDACTED] back, placing a choke hold on [REDACTED]. Lee said that during the struggle he was stabbed by [REDACTED] in his right hamstring. He said [REDACTED] was holding the knife in his right hand when he was stabbed. Lee said after he was stabbed he saw the front door and ran out. Once in the hallway he realized that he did not have his car keys or cell phone on him and then at that moment he realized he was stabbed and bleeding. Lee said that he went back to the apartment he just ran out of and was banging on the door and yelling for the persons inside to give him back his cell phone and car keys. Lee told me that he was banging on apartment doors for someone to call the police.

He then went back to the suspects apartment and told the suspects inside that he was going to pull the fire alarm and did so. He said when he pulled the fire alarm people came out of their apartments and that when suspect [REDACTED] opened his apartment door and threw his phone and keys into the hallway. Lee told me that he picked up his property and called 911. Once on the phone with 911 operators he asked a [REDACTED] who lives in apartment [REDACTED] for help and [REDACTED] got on the phone with 911 operators and gave the location of the crime. Lee told me that the next thing he remembers is the police showing up.

It should be noted that Lee collapsed from his injury in the hallway before paramedics / police arrived on scene.

Lee is desirous of prosecution.

Hermosa Beach Police officers responded to [REDACTED] Herondo Street [REDACTED] regarding a stabbing victim on 12-23-07 at about 1847 hours. Simultaneously a fire alarm is pulled at the location. Officers arrived on scene and located a subject with a stab wound to his right leg (Victim Lee). Suspects subsequently fled the location prior to police arrival. Officers contacted the two suspects who reside at [REDACTED] Herondo Street [REDACTED] Hermosa Beach (Suspects [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]) via telephone. Officer Sellan arrested the two suspects [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] at Aviation Blvd and Rosecrans Avenue, Manhattan Beach, CA on 12-23-07 at approximately 2005 hours.

After initial investigation, it is determined that the stabbing victim is a victim of conspiracy of assault with a deadly weapon (knife) and robbery by the two suspects. See crime report by Officer Sellan #168.

The knife was recovered at the scene, a folded "Buck" knife, and a matching sheath was also located in a nightstand drawer in the apartment.

On 12-23-07 at approximately 2244 hours I interviewed suspect [REDACTED] in the HBPD interview room. The interview was video and audio recorded. Suspect [REDACTED] was previously advised by Officer Brunn #165 of her rights on 12-23-07 at 2025 hours (see attached signed copy). I re-advised suspect [REDACTED] of her rights and asked her if she understood and signed the form as indicated, and she replied she did.

[REDACTED] told me essentially that [REDACTED] is her boyfriend of two years and they reside together at [REDACTED] Herondo Street [REDACTED] Hermosa Beach. [REDACTED] indicated she is in the process of being emancipated. [REDACTED] claimed that [REDACTED] recently started conversing with people on the Internet and that [REDACTED] wanted to play the "Chris Hanson guy" on the "to catch a predator" on the Internet. [REDACTED] made contact with someone "that was really weird". [REDACTED] admitted to speaking on the phone to an unknown male for the purpose of arranging a meeting with him so that [REDACTED] could scare him. [REDACTED] claimed [REDACTED] wanted to pretend he was a police officer and to "bust" this guy. [REDACTED] claimed the "guy" came over and after [REDACTED] flashed his badge/wallet and identified himself as a police officer, the guy just went crazy. There was a struggle and [REDACTED] did not know where the knife came from or how the victim or [REDACTED] got injured. [REDACTED] claimed to have jumped across the balcony to a neighbor, so she did not see the actual stabbing. [REDACTED] returned to the apartment, saw that [REDACTED] was cut and "freaked out" so she called the police on [REDACTED] phone. [REDACTED] claimed she thought the knife belonged to the guy (not [REDACTED] as she did not think [REDACTED] had a knife. [REDACTED] claimed it "wasn't a big deal" and that she didn't think anything of it and that it was funny. It was just an innocent little thing and "no big deal". The whole thing was to tell the guy "like you're gross". [REDACTED] was just trying to scare the guy and not that there "was a conspiracy to do anything to him or anything". "We just got all crazy". [REDACTED] claimed it was a "self defense thing" and that [REDACTED] didn't go at him". They were just trying to scare him, but he (the victim) went crazy. [REDACTED] denied removing anything from the pockets of the victim, claiming the victim took his own property out and placed it on the table in front of her couch as they were sitting together.

[REDACTED] would later recant some of her statements and indicate that she may have called the police from the "guy's" phone and not [REDACTED] cell phone as originally stated, but she was not sure as they were similar phones. [REDACTED] denied any involvement in the emailing to the victim, but admitted to speaking to the victim on the telephone and meeting the victim at the curbside of the residence to walk the victim to her apartment where [REDACTED] was lying in wait for the victim. [REDACTED] would deny knowing the email address used or conversing with the victim and stated [REDACTED] had done all the emailing and sharing of photos. [REDACTED] initially denied touching any of the victim's property, but later recanted indicating she did hand the property to [REDACTED] to give back to the victim so her fingerprints could be on the victim's property. [REDACTED] denied any knowledge of a plan to take the victim's property. [REDACTED] claimed she and [REDACTED] left the apartment prior to police arrival to seek medical aid for [REDACTED] cut. [REDACTED] further claimed the wound [REDACTED] received was fresh and caused by the victim's knife.

There were several discrepancies in the story told by [REDACTED], notably that [REDACTED] indicated that she may have used the victim's cell phone to call 911 due to the phones being similar phones however they were two distinctly different phones. The first 911 call received was not from [REDACTED] while the struggle was occurring, but from the victim of the crime after the stabbing occurred. Blood was also located on the sliding door and balcony area of the apartment (where [REDACTED] indicated she fled to during the actual physical altercation/stabbing). Additionally the two suspects did not respond to the hospital for medical treatment after fleeing

the scene.

Victim [REDACTED] Lee Additional Statement:

On 12-24-07 at about 0945 hours I contacted victim Lee at Little Company of Mary Hospital emergency room [REDACTED]. I asked Lee if he could identify the suspect(s) that stabbed him and he indicated that he could. I advised Lee pursuant to the HBPD photo admonition to which he indicated he understood and signed (see attached copy). I showed Lee a photograph show up that included suspect [REDACTED]. Lee immediately identified subject [REDACTED] as the suspect who stabbed him. Lee circled, initialed, dated and placed the time for subject [REDACTED]. Subject [REDACTED] is suspect [REDACTED]. I then showed Lee another photo show up and after several seconds, Lee identified subject #2 as the subject who led him into the apartment and searched his pants pockets as suspect [REDACTED] held a knife to his neck area. Lee indicated he was 90% sure subject #2 was the subject. Lee circled, initialed, indicated a 90%, dated, and placed the time for subject #2. Subject #2 is suspect [REDACTED]. Lee indicated the reason he was not 100% positive on suspect [REDACTED] is that the female suspect was wearing a long blond wig and had a red bandana on. Lee further stated the female suspect kept attempted to blind fold him with another bandana. Lee also provided a copy of his initial medical release paperwork from Little Company of Mary Hospital to me at this time.

Lee later provided photographs of his injuries which I downloaded into the HBPD system. I also received copies of the email correspondence between the suspect and the victim. Note-the victim had at one point during the email correspondence asked the suspect her age, however the suspect replied "does it matter send me a pic of ur cock". The suspect never told the victim that she was underage.

Details: On 12/23/07 at approximately 1920 hrs, I received a call from PSO Pierce regarding a stabbing that had just occurred with two outstanding suspects. Pierce was relaying information she had received from Sgt. Turek who was at the crime scene and unable to make the notification. I called Detective Scheid and Detective Saylor who both said they would meet me at the crime scene located at the [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] Herondo uni [REDACTED]

I arrived on scene twenty minutes later and met Det. Saylor, Sgt. Turek, and Officer Droz. Sgt. Turek and Officer Droz were in police uniforms. All four of us proceeded to unit [REDACTED]. As we were walking to the apartment we noticed a large amount of blood on walls, apartment doors and the hallway floor. We followed the blood trail to apartment [REDACTED]. I was informed by Sgt. Turek that no one had been in the apartment yet to declare it safe.

At the same time that we were in front of unit [REDACTED] Officer Sellan and Officer Brunn had the suspect [REDACTED] and his girlfriend [REDACTED] detained in the city of Manhattan Beach. Via Officer Droz handheld radio I asked Officer Sellan to ask [REDACTED] if it was OK to enter his apartment. Officer Sellan said [REDACTED] said yes and signed consent to search form, see attached form.

Officers' Sellan and Brunn transported [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to the HBPD jail for booking and we went into [REDACTED] apartment to collect evidence. While I was evaluating the scene and collecting evidence I received a radio transmission from Officer Sellan requesting a Detective to come to the police station to interview the suspect. Officer Sellan said that [REDACTED] had "pleaded" to talk to a detective. [REDACTED] wanted to tell his side of the story in the hopes of clearing everything up.

I left the crime scene and drove to the station and met with Officer Sellan who gave me a brief synopsis of what [REDACTED] had told him.

Details: On 12/23/07 at approximately 2100 hrs, I interviewed [REDACTED] for the first time. Because he was in custody I read him each of his Miranda rights. [REDACTED] said he understood each question and agreed to talk to me. The following is essentially what [REDACTED] told me:

Interview #1

Statement:

Note: It should be noted that throughout the interview [REDACTED] was in a very excitable state. He had trouble completing a thought, claimed he could not remember a lot of details, and was easily distracted. He usually answered my questions in incomplete sentences and on occasion he would give me varied/different answers to the same question.

[REDACTED] said that he had posted a personal advertisement on "Craigslist" website. He stated the ad said; I'm a fourteen year old virgin girl in Los Angeles who wants to have sex. It was posted on "Craigslist" under the heading "Parents not Home". [REDACTED] would not be more specific than that. He said he posted the ad to catch sexual predators, "Like on the show Dateline NBC". [REDACTED] said he was trying to be like "Chris Hanson" the host of the show.

[REDACTED] stated he had a number of emails from people who were interested, including victim LEE. [REDACTED] said that he wrote the ad and did all the written correspondence. [REDACTED] claimed that the verbal communication (cell phone) was done by his girlfriend [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said I was just trying to do the "right thing"; he was trying to catch a predator so he could impress his criminal justice professor at IT. [REDACTED] claimed that after a few phone conversations between suspect [REDACTED] and victim [REDACTED] Lee, they decided to lure Lee to their apartment under the ruse that he was going to have sex with a 14yr girl. [REDACTED] also said that he asked [REDACTED] to ask Lee to bring over as much "weed" (marijuana) as he could. [REDACTED] said all he wanted to do is to get the "guy" over to his house so he could buy the "bud" (marijuana) off him.

I asked [REDACTED] what happened when Lee came to his apartment. [REDACTED] said, "He comes over, so I'm like look dude I just want to buy some bud. He fucking flips the fuck out".

[REDACTED] did not recall a lot of details from this point.

During the interview this verbal exchange took place regarding the crime:

[REDACTED] said he and victim Lee wrestled for a little bit, then Lee "scurries" out the room. [REDACTED] said he looked at his finger and its bleeding, but he does not recall getting injured. [REDACTED] said, "Then there's other blood, I'm like, I'm like, Oh, my god my life is over." [REDACTED] then denied having a knife in his hand. I then asked [REDACTED] if Lee had the knife and [REDACTED] said, "He grabbed it", but [REDACTED] could not elaborate. Then [REDACTED] yelled out, "I had nothing to do with hurting him."

I asked [REDACTED] about the buck knife we found in his apartment. [REDACTED] said the knife was his. He said [REDACTED] gave the buck knife to him as a gift/reward for completing one full year of

sobriety. I asked [redacted] if he had been drinking today and he said, "Yes, earlier".

I made several attempts to redirect [redacted] to the specifics of the crime:

Det Lewis [redacted] at any time did you have the buck knife (found on his bed in his room with blood and flesh on it) in your hand?

[redacted] [pause] No, no.

Later same question

Det Lewis: Did you at any time have the buck knife in your hand?

[redacted] No, because I was looking for it.

Later same question

Det. Lewis: Did you at any time have the knife in your hands- any kind of knife?

[redacted] [longer pause] When the door was locked I might have grabbed one.

Det. Lewis: While he (victim Lee) was in the room?

[redacted] No, no, honestly, I don't remember please I don't remember. I'm not a killer. [redacted] is visibly upset).

I tried a number of times to go step by step with [redacted] in order to reenact the incident, but every time I would begin, [redacted] would interrupt me by asking questions that did not pertain to the specific step in the process, for example; I asked [redacted] where he was when Lee walked through the door and [redacted] would respond by saying things like, do you think I'll be able to spend Christmas with my family. I ended the interview without getting a more responsive conduct from [redacted] at that point.

Interview #2:

At approximately 2245hrs, Detective McColgan and I re-interviewed [redacted]. We told [redacted] we had talked to all parties involved and we had more questions for him. I advised him that he was still under the rules of Miranda. [redacted] indicated that he understood. The following is essentially what [redacted] told us:

[redacted] said he was playing around trying to catch an online predator, but decided to, according to [redacted] "I'll get the weed off this dude." I asked [redacted] how he planned to take the marijuana off Lee, [redacted] said, "Not, no, there was no, I did not threaten him with any weapon. OK."

Detective McColgan told [redacted] that he was not telling the truth and was going to give him one more chance to start over. Det. McColgan tells [redacted] to take a deep breath and to relax. Det. McColgan again tries to interview [redacted] but noticed he was reluctant to answer the questions. Det. McColgan is standing during the interview and reaches over and hits to stop recording button on the tape-recorder. [redacted] says, "Am I still being recorded, fuck-it I don't care."

██████████ was still being audio and visually recorded. During that time ██████████ admitted he planned, set-up, and executed a plan to get victim Lee to his apartment. ██████████ said once Lee was in his apartment he showed him an open buck knife and told Lee he was with the Hermosa Beach Police Department. ██████████ also admitted that while Lee was in the apartment, his girlfriend ██████████ reached into Lee's pants pockets and took his car keys and cell phone out of his pockets while ██████████ held an open buck knife to his chest. ██████████ added that he also asked Lee to take off his pants because he wanted to make sure Lee was unarmed. ██████████ said that at that point Lee got behind him and put his arm around ██████████ neck. ██████████ said that he then took the buck knife that was in his right hand and stabbed Lee in the thigh area. Lee then got up and ran out the door.

██████████ said Lee came back to get his cell phone or keys. ██████████ said Lee banged on his front door and yelled for his things. ██████████ said he told the guy to go away or he'll call the police, then Lee pulls the fire alarm. ██████████ said he then opened the door and threw Lee's cell phone and keys out and into the hallway.

██████████ said that he was afraid and he and ██████████ left the building. While they are driving around he called 911. The dispatcher advised him to pull over and wait for the police.

Detective McColgan then re-interviewed ██████████ with the tape-recorder on going step by step over each detail of the crime. The following is essentially what ██████████ told Detective McColgan:

██████████ said that he created an ad and an email address in order to catch an online predator. ██████████ said that he interacted with victim Lee over the internet via emails. ██████████ sends Lee a photo of a girl claiming that she is the girl in the online ad. Victim Lee then sends ██████████ a photo of himself. ██████████ said that they exchanged phone numbers so they could work out the details of a rendezvous. ██████████ said that he wrote all the written communication under the ruse of being a female looking for sex. Once the telephone numbers were exchanged, ██████████ said, his girlfriend ██████████ did all the verbal communication.

██████████ and Lee spoke a number of times over the phone and decided to get together. ██████████ said that ██████████ told Lee that she would be standing out in front of the ██████████ located at ██████████ Herondo Street. She had long blond hair and would be wearing all black. Lee and ██████████ talked between 3 to 4 times while he was en-route to the location.

Lee arrived, parked, and met ██████████ ██████████ then took Lee to unit ██████████ the apartment she shares with ██████████. Lee walks into the apartment and sits on the sofa. ██████████ said he came into the apartment, showed Lee an open buck knife and yelled he was from Hermosa Beach Police. ██████████ also accused Lee of being a sick pervert.

██████████ said while Lee was sitting on the sofa he put the open buck knife against Lee's chest and asked Lee if he had a gun. ██████████ then demanded Lee take off his pants. ██████████ said he did that because he did not want Lee to access a weapon he may have in his pants. ██████████ said that Lee got angry and got behind him. ██████████ said that Lee put his arm around his neck and was holding him. ██████████ said he then reach back with his right hand and stabbed Lee in the right thigh area.
