

RESOLUTION NO. 07-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH, TO NOT MERGE TWO CONTIGUOUS LOTS ON PROPERTY COMMONLY KNOWN AS 1245 7TH PLACE, LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS LOTS 29 AND 30, BLOCK 139, REDONDO VILLA TRACT

The Planning Commission of the City of Hermosa Beach does hereby resolve and order as follows:

Section 1. A public hearing was conducted, pursuant to Chapter 16.20 of the Subdivision Ordinance, to consider whether or not to merge the two lots that comprise the subject property.

Section 2. The Planning Commission conducted a hearing on the matter on May 15, 2007, at which testimony and evidence, both written and oral, were presented to and considered by the Planning Commission.

Section 3. Based on the evidence received at the public hearing, the Planning Commission makes the following findings:

1. The property is located on a block that is unusual in that the north side is characterized by a uniform pattern of 25-foot wide lots with only one 50-foot wide parcel out of eighteen while the south side is comprised of lots that are 40-foot wide and are a mix of "half lots" and "through lots."
2. Given that a vast majority of the lots within this block on the north of 7th Place are similar in size and width, and merger of the lots would adversely impact the existing integrity of the north side of the block, and therefore, the neighborhood.

Section 4. Based on the foregoing, the Planning Commission and hereby releases from merger lots 29 and 30, Block 139 of the Redondo Villa Tract and directs staff to file for record with the County Recorder's office a release of the notice of intention and a notice for non-merger.
