A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH, CALIFORNIA, TO ADOPT AN AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE HERMOSA BEACH MANAGEMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, employees of the City of Hermosa Beach, California represented by the Hermosa Beach Management Employees Association Bargaining Unit have elected to meet and confer with the City of Hermosa Beach on matters concerning wages, hours, and working conditions; and,

WHEREAS, the above personnel have selected certain individuals to represent them; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding has been ratified by a majority of the members of the Hermosa Beach Management Employees Association; and,

AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH AND THE HERMOSA BEACH MANAGEMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION

The following language shall be added as new language to the existing Article 6, entitled Additional Compensation of the existing Memorandum of Understanding.

## ARTICLE 6 - ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION

In keeping with current employment trends for public sector executives, the City Manager may authorize additional incentives upon initial appointment that may include such items as reimbursement of reasonable relocation expenses, temporary housing assistance up to a maximum of \$15,000, and/or establishing balances or advances in accumulated vacation or sick leave. Any expense reimbursements shall be supported by appropriate receipts and made in accordance with established City policies.
