#### **Background:**

At its meeting of April 10, 2007, the City Council directed the City Clerk to advertise and request applications from interested parties for the above board/commission terms. A notice advertising the expiring terms and inviting applications was published in the Easy Reader April 19 and 26 and was posted (at City Hall, in the Library, and on the City's webpage), with a filing deadline of 6 p.m. Tuesday, May 15. All incumbents were notified by mail of the need to file an application by the deadline in order to be considered for reappointment.

Applications for both the Civil Service Board and the Planning Commission were received from only the incumbents. Since there are only two applicants for the two seats on each of these commissions, there seems no need for interviews, and it is recommended that the Council this evening reappoint: (1) Susan Blaco and Barry Warner to the Civil Service Board to the four-year terms ending July 15, 2011; and (2) Peter Hoffman and Sam Perrotti to the Planning Commission for the four-year terms ending June 30, 2011.

There are three applications for the Parks, Recreation and Community Ser vices Advisory Commission. It is therefore recommended that interviews be scheduled to take place at 6:15 p.m. on June 12, with appointments to follow later that evening at the regular meeting.


