TRAFFIC CONCERNS ON 5TH STREET

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Public Works Commission review the report and provide input to staff.

Summary:

At the May 28, 2003 meeting of the Public Works Commission, residents of 5th Street spoke to the issues of speeding and truck traffic on 5th Street just above Pacific Coast Highway.

In response to the residents' requests, staff submitted a memo to the Chief of Police requesting increased enforcement on this portion of 5th Street. In addition, the Public Works Department is considering the installation of "No Commercial Trucks" signage at this location. Staff will also present the results of a new speed survey.
